Summary

The Holy Spirit was sent by God the Father in the name of Jesus Christ. Therefore, the Holy Spirit is an ascension gift of Jesus Christ.

The Holy Spirit always magnifies Jesus Christ. The Holy Spirit is “the promise of the Father.” There are more than 3,000 promises in Scripture, but only one is called “the promise of the Father” (Acts 1:4; Luke 24:49).

This truth assures all believers that the Holy Spirit indwells them and never leaves them.
