Now that we know the origin of Satan - his names, where he works and how he works - the only weapon to defeat him is the Word of God. Jesus used the Word (Matthew 4). Paul instructs us concerning the enemy and how to overcome him in our lives (Ephesians 6:12-17).

Satan is free on earth only in the permissive will of God. He cannot go beyond God's permission - but we must carry out our responsibilities as Christians. We should not give Satan a chance (Ephesians 4:27). We should always accept God's way of escape when tempted (1 Corinthians 10:13).

Our Lord is Omnipotent, Omniscient and Omnipresent. He is always with us (1 Peter 5:7). Also, 1 John 4:4.
